RE: Phase 2: Step 1 Survey

The attached tables reflect the survey results identifying your individual preferences for alternatives to continue in the Vision 54/56 evaluation. Also included are the raw survey results for your review. The summary tables will form the basis of the discussion that will take place at the November 30th Task Force Meeting. At the Task Force Meeting, you will be asked as a collective group to recommend a set of alternatives to the MPO Board. Here are a couple of quick notes to consider as you review the survey results.

Two tables have been prepared for each intersection. Table 1 for US 41 and Table 3 for Little Road are sorted based on the weighted score for each alternative. The weighting is a descending 5-points to 1-point scale going from first ranked alternative to fifth ranked alternative. Since Alternative 10 could have been selected multiples times by each survey respondent, the summary table (Table 1 and Table 3) only reflects the highest ranked Alternative 10 submitted by each survey respondent. All Alternative 10 combinations are reflected in Table 2 and Table 4.

Table 2 and Table 4 show the complete responses provided in the survey for the Alternative 10 combinations. Therefore, the Response Count in Table 2 and Table 4 are higher than those shown in Table 1 and Table 3 respectively.

There were 12 surveys received for the Little Road intersection and 13 surveys for the US 41 intersection. Since the survey is conducted anonymously, we are not able to identify who submitted a survey. As you review these materials, please look to see if the survey you submitted has been recorded accurately. Also, note that each intersection had one survey that was identified as incomplete and was included in the summary tables.
